

Rules & Regulations for the Poster Contest

1. Entries will be no larger than 56 cm x 71 cm.
2. Please choose which contest you would like to enter and use only the following:
Colour poster: Full colour
Black and White: Pencil, charcoal and/or India Ink – (no colour)
3. Posters can be on paper or Bristol Board. Submissions using materials such as canvas, photopaper, or made of craft material such as foam, textiles or wood will not be accepted.
4. The poster shall reflect REMEMBRANCE with a Canadian theme. If symbols are used, Canadian symbols shall be pre-eminent.
5. Candidates must complete an official Registration Form, available from the local Legion branch or online at; <https://www.remembrancecontests.ca/> and attach it to their entry with glue or tape. (**No staples please**)
6. Only one person may submit an entry. (No group entries)
7. Winning posters, at the national level, will be framed and placed on display at the Canadian War Museum in Ottawa for one year. Second and third place national level winners will be displayed at Parliament Hill during the week of Remembrance. All artworks will be returned to the Districts through Provincial Commands.
8. Students who have been out of the educational system for more than two consecutive years are ineligible to compete in the Poster Contest at any level.
9. Contestants may enter both the Colour Contest and the Black and White Contest but may submit only one entry for each category.
10. **All entries are to be submitted to the local Legion branch.**
